- The next meeting will be Thursday, April 14, a week earlier than usual because of Holy Week.

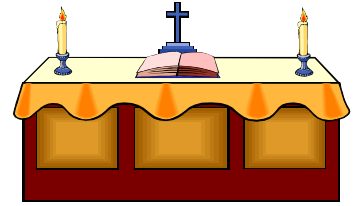

## Prayer Vigil –

It has long been the tradition at St. James' to keep a continuous vigil before the Reserved Sacrament from the end of the Maundy Thursday Service to the beginning of the Good Friday Service. During this time of prayer we take turns watching through the night of our Savior's arrest and trial.

You may watch for a whole hour or split the time with fellow watchers. The vigil must be continuous. Occasionally, we have had to cancel the vigil because there have been large gaps. We hope and trust that will not happen this year. The sign-up sheet is posted in the Undercroft.

The watch will be from 8:00 PM April 21, 2010 until NOON April 22 in St. Mary's Chapel. Materials will be available for study and devotions.

**What happens to the flowers after Sunday?** Our "flower angel" Shirley Caw takes bouquets to shut-ins, newcomers, and sometimes to someone "just because". With the flowers she leaves a card: "These flowers have been on the altar of St. James Episcopal Church. They have heard the hymns that have been sung, the prayers that have been said, and the sermon that has been preached. Now they come to you in their silent beauty to tell you all about it, and to bring you cheer and our good wishes."
