Dear St. James Family,

Based upon the estimates for replacement that we have received this will cost approx. \$500 per window.

The parish needs your help. All I am asking is that you do what you can. We will leave the rest to God. That means if you can give \$25...thank you. If you can give \$2500...thank you. If you can give me a prayer for the success of this project and new life for our parish...thank you. Any gift is deeply appreciated.

I am hoping you will find some rest during this summer.

I am planning to take a vacation at the end of July for a couple weeks. I will only miss one Sunday. On that Sunday there will be Morning Prayer in the parish.

I may also be away a week at the end of September, but that is still to be determined.

May these summer months be great for you and your family. Join your parish family in prayer each Sunday and give thanks to God for all the good things we have received.

May 18, 2011

All members in attendance.

Fr. Willmann opened the meeting with prayer.

The agenda was approved

Minutes of the April 14 meeting were approved following corrections to clarify language in the treasurer's report.

Father Willmann reported that he and all delegates attended the reconvening of the 136th Diocesan Convention on May 7. A new method of calculation of the Mission Share was approved. This new method will only slightly lower our annual share to the diocese beginning next year.

Vestry approved continuing Children's Sunday School through the summer months.

Vestry continues to review presentations for replacement of windows in St. James House and hopes to soon begin a fund raising campaign for the project.

Treasurer Eleanor Bailey reported that (Complete minutes and financial reports are available in the office.) although current giving income is slightly above expectation for the first third of the year we need to be very cautious with our cash flow.

Coffee Hour

Outreach: Carol Cavinee reported that the next committee meeting will be June 5. The committee has designated next Sunday's Second Basket offering as Undies Sunday and will collect donations of new underwear for the clothing bank at Eastside Ministry.

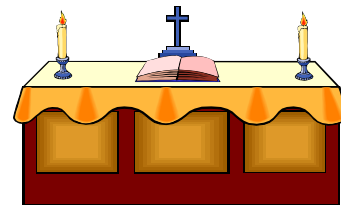
